

Virtual Courses Information

In accordance with Board Policy IGCD, the Excelsior Springs School District will accept all grades and credits earned through Launch and MOCAP. The district will pay the costs of virtual courses only if the the student's request for enrollment in the course has first been approved by the building principal.

Registration Deadline (forms to request enrollment can be obtained from building offices)

For Fall Semester	April 30th
For Spring Semester	November 30th

Open Enrollment Periods

For Fall Semester	last 10 school days of the prior school year
For Spring Semester	last 10 school days of the fall semester

FAQ's

Does taking a virtual course exempt me from taking the coinciding MAP or EOC course?

No. Students approved for virtual courses must still take MAP or EOC required assessments that coincide with the virtual course being taken.

Does the district provide the equipment and Internet access for me to take a virtual course?

The district is not obligated to provide students computers, equipment, or Internet access to take virtual courses unless otherwise required by law to accommodate a student with a disability.

Where do I take my virtual course?

Students approved for virtual courses must do so off school grounds unless arrangements have been made with building administration otherwise.

How many virtual courses can I take?

Students may enroll in courses up to the equivalent of full-time enrollment in the district.

Can my request to enroll in a virtual course be denied?

Yes. If the building principal determines virtual courses are not in the best educational interest of the student, requests for enrollment will be refused. Appeals of those decisions can be made with the Board of Education.
